RULES in addition to I.I.B.A. Rules:

****1.** A team shall consist of 16 players (4 rinks) with a minimum of 6 ladies and at least 1 lady on each rink. In the event of a player being absent from a rink, at least 1 lady **MUST** be included in that rink.

2. Each team will play two matches – home and away. Matches must not be arranged for dates after those specified and must not be postponed except in extenuating circumstances in which case the fixture must be re-arranged and played within 14 days of the date originally fixed.

3. The home team shall have a choice of mats.

4. In the event of a tie after the two matches have been played, an extra end will be played by all four rinks on the same mat as they played their previous ten ends with the jack being in possession of the skip of each winning rink on its last end.

5. The winning team's secretary or captain will be responsible for sending the score cards signed by the losing team's secretary or captain to the Zone Convenor immediately after each match.

6. Two dead ends are allowed by each side and are replayed. For third and subsequent dead ends the offending side will be penalised by the award of three shots to their opponents and the ends shall be counted as ends played.

****NOTE:-** I would ask that you take a careful look at rule 1, which has been changed. This relates to the number of ladies on each rink and on the Team. It is of prime importance that all results are sent to me by the winning secretary after the end of each match.
